The Committee wants to ensure there is a high-performance pathway through St Clare's for players aspiring for higher representative honours, and the development of the netball program over future years will demonstrate this.

On behalf of the Committee and the wider netball club, my sincere thanks to the St Clare's College PE Department, particularly Ms Louise Patton, and the teachers who have supported the program in 2025, either at school with administration or coming to Deakin to watch the girls compete. Your support demonstrates to the girls and parents that their contribution to the college on a weekend is recognised, meaningful and worthwhile. My thanks also to the school community council, in particular Dr John Norgrove, for their support with a range of decisions and various guidance as required.

#### **2025 highlights and achievements**

- 18 teams competing weekly, with over 180 players involved.
- 15+ umpires officiating junior and senior matches.
- Volunteer coaches, managers, and supporters showing up every week.
- Expanded parent committee: from 6 to 10 dedicated volunteers in the second year, improved sponsorship and fundraising activities which raised a combined total of \$7,410.
- Seniors Div 1 – 1st team, coached by Rhiana Webb and Angela Bartkowiak (Manager) finished second in the regular season, narrowly missing the Grand Final after a spirited semi-final.
- Intermediate Division 1 (Year 7 team): Undefeated Premiers and Grand Final Winners.
- New supporter wear and playing dresses were ordered by families online directly with ISC, and garments arrived in week 2 of the competition (May).
- Team photos taken by volunteer parent and provided to teams at no cost.
- Two major fundraising raffles (Easter & Father's Day) generating more than \$1,000 revenue.
- Volunteers supporting a fundraising BBQ at the school athletics carnival.
- Weekly club newsletter to database of over 150 parents plus coordinated team / club WhatsApp chat group which assisted with volunteer duty management, sponsor recognition and community building.
- Monthly committee meetings with minutes recorded.
- Grand final evening gathering at Canberra Southern Cross Club Woden, approximately 50 people to celebrate the season.
- St Clare's players recognised by SCNA with individual awards for achievement within their respective competitions.
- Leveraged social media to promote the school and club, including a great video made by the Saturday Netball Sports Captains.
- End of season parent and coach survey conducted.

These achievements reflect the strength of our club culture and the commitment of everyone involved from players and families to staff, coaches and volunteers.

### **Areas for improvement for 2026**

1. Recruitment of new players to increase participation beyond 18 teams.
2. Recruitment and retention of umpires to support more SCNA fixtures each weekend.
3. Alignment of player selections for respective Division 1 teams with SCNA policy for the best players to be selected within each age division regardless of school year.
4. Improved planning and timing of key netball program activities:
  - A) Coach nominations and appointments (December 2025) – no volunteers to be turned away or considered as surplus to requirements.
  - B) Player registrations, selection trials and team selections / announcements.
  - C) Coach and umpire mentoring and development.
5. School netball facilities and equipment – school gymnasium floor, first aid kits and goal post pads.
6. Record keeping and acknowledgement of St Clare's students with representative achievements.
